Project outcomes:

- > Students' are highly influenced by their Family members and academicians in career decision process which implies family support and institutional consulting support after graduation are imperative in students' career deciding options.
- Family background of a student plays an imperative role in inclination towards entrepreneurship. Accordingly, father and mother education, occupation and family monthly income have robust influence on student entrepreneurship.
- > Students participating in seminar, conferences, training and workshops organised at their institution relating to entrepreneurship influences inclination towards entrepreneurship.
- > Students have also opined that the entrepreneurial learning programme at their institution has enhanced communication skill and leadership skill which are significant to venture a business.
- Entrepreneurial Characteristics has positive effect on stimulating students' entrepreneurial intention. The students having self confidence with high need for achievement, greater innovation and have the willingness to take risk lead to higher entrepreneurial intention.
- The indirect effects of entrepreneurship education on entrepreneurship intention are high when it is mediated through entrepreneurial characteristics. It reveals that entrepreneurship education have an indirect positive influence on entrepreneurship intention.
- Lack of capital and lack of business experience are the impediments foreseen by students for their business startups.
