



Common Instructions for all the students regarding reopening on 10th February 2021

- Classes will commence for II and III UG and II PG day scholars on 10th February 2021.
- I UG classes to start from 15th February 2021 and I PG classes shall commence from 1st March 2021.
- Students are requested to submit a self-declaration form signed by the parent and the student on the date of reopening. They are requested to refer the college website for all guidelines regarding reopening.
- The college will work in two shifts with 3 hours/day
 - FN(9 am to 12 noon)-Aided and PG
 - AN (1 to 4 pm) -SF
- The morning shift students can check in from 8 am and the afternoon shift students from 12 noon.
- Students/Staff vehicle parking will be at the back gate.
- Students on entering the campus to move to their allotted rooms and to be seated as per social distancing norms.
- The room allotment will be put up in the college website.
- Students are not to gather in groups inside the campus.
- Students to compulsorily wear masks.
- Students will be permitted to use their mobile inside the campus for study purpose.
- Sharing of food items and gadgets is strictly prohibited.

- The students are to be directed to disperse immediately after the classes.
- Students are requested to strictly follow all the instructions given by their faculty members.
- Online classes will be continued by the faculty members for the benefit of the hostel students.
- The following III year UG and II year PG students will have practical classes from **10.2.2021 to 5.3.2021**(3 weeks). GRG hostel students can stay in the hostel during this period
