Admissions:

She explained about the response for B.Voc degree programme from the public .There was very good response for B.Voc garment designing as there is a connecting PG Course namely M.Sc Costume Design & Fashion. Since we have an established garment industry in and around Coimbatore there is very good demand for the course.

For B.Voc Beauty Therapy & Aesthetics the response was moderate

The total training cost, complete course material, Examination fees, NSDC Certificate exam fees etc were met out of grant given by UGC.

Industrial Visit:

Since UGC allocated separate funds for industrial visits it was utilized to the maximum extent possible and the students& staffs were taken to respective industries in and around Coimbatore.

Hands on training:

The college has signed MOU with more than 30 Garments and Beauty Industries. Students regularly go for internship to companies during working days as well as holidays and they are trained well by partner industries.

Resolved to thank industry partners for their support and enthusiastic participation for the skill development degree programmes by giving hands on training and guest lecturers during 2014-2015 and requested them to continue their support in the coming years.
