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2. Fees Structure :

The Secretary informed that as per UGC regulations, Registration fees of Rs.1,800 is only collected from the students for one year course wherein they can complete 3 levels. i.e.,

4. Assessment by sector skill council:

The dean vocational programmers Mrs.G.Kalavathi explained about the assessment done by sector skill council for community college students .Assessment by sector skill council is made mandatory by UGC.The Apparel Made ups and Home Furnishing Sector skill council appointed qualified assessing officers for assessment and the assessment was completed for the following community college garment designing courses students on 30.06.2015

Certificate level	35 Students
Diploma Level	15 Students

All the students have done their assessment well and the assessment officer appreciated the work done by community college students. The members appreciated and recorded the same.

Record note books and the samples made by the students for sector skill assessment were displayed to the members. The members appreciated the work done by the community college students.

5. Internship and hands on training to students:

The secretary briefed the MOU with 26 Garment Industries in Coimbatore and Tirupur and the community college students were sent to these industries for hands on training during the working days in the afternoon and on Saturdays and Sundays and during semester holidays.

Multimedia students were given hands on training in the college itself by CampusImages Company Ltd.with whom we have a MOU for Multimedia & Animation.

6. Role of partner industries in placement

The secretary briefed about the role of partner industries and placed a request to the representatives of partner industries to help the students of community college in the following areas:-

- (i) Skill training required for various job roles and existing skill demand details for various job roles in order to know the level at which the skill has to be imparted.
- (ii) Permit the students to have hands on training in the partner industries during week days in the afternoon.
- (iii) Permit the students to get trained for placement in industries. When they are doing their internship in the industries.

7. Statement of accounts for 2014-2015:

The statement of accounts of community college for 2014-15 was placed before the BOM Members. The members discussed in detail and recorded the same.

8. Suggestions given by Members:

- (i) The college can register for providing various skills training under the Pradhan Manthiri Yojana Scheme.
- (ii) Train the trainer (TOT) Programme available at partner industries to be utilized by the faculty.
- (iii) The partner industries can design a part of the curriculum and make the student to work with them for 15 days. The industry will certify them. Then the students can go for the next level and get certified so that the students can be certified by the industry for different job role.
- (iv) The college can establish an innovation centre in multimedia & Animation for the training of students in different projects.
