Minutes of advisory committee meeting of B.Voc Degree programmes held on 20.03.2020.

1.Dr.S.Nirmala,Principal & Member secretary welcomed the members and briefed the working of B.Voc degree programmes at PSGRKCW.She commented that admissions for B.Voc Garment Designing is very good but admissions for B.Voc – Beauty Therapy for IInd year B.Voc and IIIrd year B.Voc has to be improved.

2.Mrs Shanthipriya replied that after doing Ist year diploma in beauty therapy many students get placement but in future they will come for advanced Diploma Programmes.

Workshops with hands on training:

Mrs.Karpagavalli HOD of garment designing department reported that 8 hands on training workshops were conducted by leading technical persons in garment industry .In most of the workshops hands on training was given to the students.

3. Internship:

All B.Voc Garment Designing students have completed 120 hours of effective training at leading garment industries in Coimbatore and Tirupur, Erode, Karur, Chennai etc., The internship at our partner industries has given exposure to the students about different activities carried on in a export oriented Garment Industry. B.Voc beauty therapy students regularly go for internship and part time cooperate beauty studios.

4. EVANZA 2020:

Department of B.Voc garment designing & B.Voc Beauty Therapy organized a mega designer show event namely EVANZA 2020.It is an Inter Collegiate meet of all designers from Tamil Nadu.

I B.Voc Garment Designing designed students and exhibited on the stage more than 25 children dresses.

II B.Voc Garment Designing & III B.Voc Garment Designing students exhibited more than 120 garments with ethnic value and with Aesthetics designs. Hair style, Face makeup was done to all models by B.Voc Beauty Therapy students.

Exhibition:

Mrs.Karpagavalli, HOD of Garment Designing department reported that all the IIIrd year B.Voc Garment Designing students, under their Portfolio Management subject the students should design 5 garments in the VI semester .So totally .more than 400 Attires designed by them were displayed in an exhibition cum sale in the PSGRKCW Alumni Auditorium.

Dean G.Kalavathi, Vocational programmes reported about the placement .Very big companies from Tirupur visit our campus for placement of students. Interested students got placement in Garment industries .Some of them have become entrepreneurs, Some of them go for higher studies. All the B.Voc Beauty Therapy Students are well placed and they got placement when they go for internship itself. Many of them get part time jobs when they go for internship in the second year of their degree programme.

MOU:

B.Voc Beauty Therapy has entered into MOU with YLG Institut Bangalore for assessment, Placement Training etc.Visiting faculty from YLG Institut conducted workshops.YIG institut conducted the assessment for the III B.Voc beauty therapy students by online.

Suggestion by members:

Suggested certain points for development of the course:

1. They suggested to add some more garment industries, Boutiques in Chennai & Bangalore for internship. They will help us to sign MOU with some leading Garment Industries and Beauty salons in Chennai & Bangalore.
2. They also suggested that campus companies can be started by students outside the college with the guidance and support from faculty members.
3. Secretary Dr.N.Yesodhadevi suggested that students can form small groups in an area and set up their own business when they are in the II nd year itself.
