Minutes of the Board of management held on 18.07.2019

- 1) The chairman welcomed the members present and explained about the functioning of the community college courses.
- 2) Principal Dr.S.Nirmala reported that students appeared for level 4 assessment for Asst.Fashion designer job role and also informed the committee members that students have successfully passed the sector skill assessment with good credentials.

Soft copies of the certificate were received from NSDC.

She reported that 50 students from community college Multimedia & Animation course appeared for Level 4 assessment for Animator Job role .The assessment was done by Media Sector Skill Council.

All the 50 students have successfully completed the assessment with good credentials and certificates were received for all the students from Media Sector Skill Council.

The committee members discussed the following matters.

The Nodal officer and Dean Mrs.G.Kalavathi gave a report on the activities of Community College.

1. The UGC grant for the current academic year 2018-19 has not yet been received .so members advised the college office to send the utilization certificate before 31.03.19.

2. Scholarship to Community College students:

The students of Community College are given scholarship and the materials required for the course are given at free of cost to students including the materials required for model exams and semester exams.

3. Fees paid for sector skill assessment:

For Community College students the exam fees of Rs. 800 per student to be remitted for the purpose of sector skill assessment to Apparels & Home Furnishings Sector Skill Council and Media Sector Skill Council. It is directly paid by the college from the grant to be received.

4. Internship:

The Community College students regularly go for internship to respective industries namely garment industries in and around Coimbatore and at Thiruppur. The multimedia students went to multimedia companies and advertising companies.

5. Industrial Visit:

All the community college students should go for industrial visit .So they were taken to Thread Garden - Ooty for an industrial visit and KG.Denim limited at mettupalayam for an industrial visit.

6. Statement of accounts for the year 2018-19:

The utilisation certificate duly audited for the grant to be given by UGC for community college courses is ready and it will be sent by 31.03.2020.

7. Designer show competition EVANZA 19:

Participation of community college students in the designer show EVANZA 2019 conducted by the department of B.Voc Garment Designing.

All the community college students presented their garments on the stage and participated in the designer show competition and won prizes. The dresses designed by community college – Garment designing course students were very good and was appreciated by the judges.

8. Campus Company - Vogue & Style – A GRG Campus Company :

GRG Trust has supported the community college students by providing space for starting a model campus company. It is a model boutique where the B.Voc – Garment Designing course students and Community College – Garment Designing students are given practical training in doing a Boutique Business by setting up a small business unit inside the college .They share the profit based on investment and also based on their contribution to the income of the Boutique. Some community college students have taken steps to set up their own Boutique based on their experience in the college .The department is giving the necessary consultation to their students. Some community college students are placed in the nearby garment industries and multimedia students are doing job work to multimedia companies.

9. Suggestions given by Board Members:

Some of the Board members suggested that the college can arrange for some courses at NIFT Chennai or Bangalore for the community college students to enrich their practical knowledge.

The board of studies members who frame the syllabus should include faculty from NIFT, Garment industry owners or chief executives and for Multimedia & Animation course members from Multimedia companies to be included.

The nodal officer Mrs.G.Kalavathi replied that efforts are taken to do some courses at NIFT and the BOS members includes professors from NIFT Chennai. The college is also organizing courses at International level for Community College students also.

With a vote of thanks by Dr.S.Nirmala the principal of the college the meeting came to an end.
