Figure1: Preferred Learning Styles

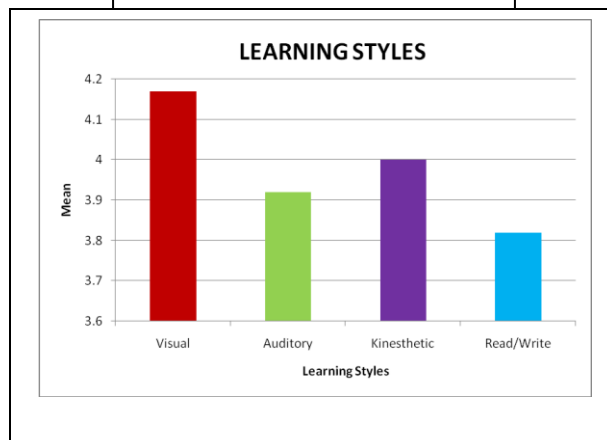
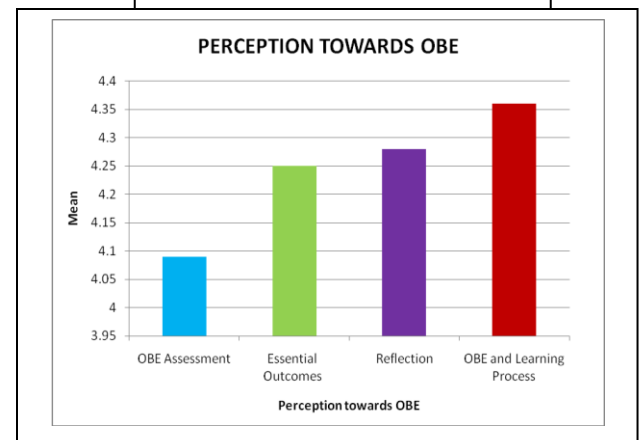


Figure 2: Perception Towards OBE
