NODAL TRAINING INSTITUTE (NTI) AGRI-CLINICS AND AGRI-BUSINESS CENTRES SCHEME (AC&ABC)



KCW is recognized as a Nodal Training Institute under the AC&ABC Scheme by the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare, Government of India, in association with NABARD and implemented through MANAGE, Hyderabad. The first batch of 23 trainees received funding of ₹ 5,34,000/- in April-May 2022. Ten trainees became entrepreneurs, and three successful start-ups emerged in sericulture, areca plate processing, and agri-clinic. The beneficiaries receive handholding support, including managerial, technical, and financial consultancy.


