

Report on the Inauguration of KCW-CARES Centre for Energy Studies

The KCW-Cares Centre for Energy Studies was inaugurated on 21st October 2024 at 9:10 AM. Located in the R Block of the college campus, this centre is designed to further the mission of bridging industry and academia by offering students opportunities in the growing field of renewable energy and sustainable development.

The inauguration ceremony was led by Mr. Arpit Sharma, CEO of the Skill Council for Green Jobs, New Delhi. He was joined by Dr. R. Nandini, Chairperson of KCW, Dr. Raguram Arjunan, Managing Director of Cares Renewables Pvt. Ltd., Coimbatore, The Secretary of KCW, Dr.N.Yesodha Devi and the Principal Dr.P.B.Harathi, KCW. The centre will act as a collaborative platform between Industry and Academia, enabling students to gain hands-on training and practical knowledge that aligns with the Skill Council's mission to build a skilled workforce in India's green job sector.

The Skill Council for Green Jobs operates under the National Skill Development Mission of the Government of India. Promoted by the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) and the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), the council provides skill training for academic institutions and industries alike across various sectors, including renewable energy, energy storage, biomass, water and waste management, and biofuels.
