The 33rd Academic Council meeting was conducted on 17 December 2025 in hybrid mode.

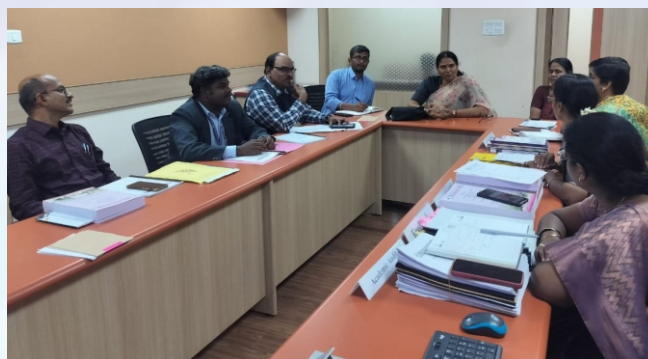
Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) report

An Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) - was conducted for the period 2022 - 25 during the 2nd and 3rd weeks of August 2025. The audit was executed in two distinct stages to evaluate and enhance academic quality, administrative efficiency, and institutional effectiveness.

Stage I: Academic Audit

An Academic Audit was conducted for all departments with 24 subject experts from various eminent institutions. The self-evaluative reports of the departments were sent to the concerned subject experts prior to the audit. The experts verified the documents, held interactive sessions with faculty and students and submitted the audit report.

Stage II: Administrative Audit



The Administrative Audit was conducted on 26 August 2025 by a panel of distinguished academic administrators: Dr. R. Ganesan, Professor, School of Computer Science and Engineering, VIT Chennai; Dr. Baba Gnanakumar, Professor, Kristu Jayanti College, Bangalore and Dr. V. Arulmurugan, Associate Professor & Head, Department of Commerce, School of Management and Campus Coordinator, Pondicherry University. The team evaluated KCW's performance over three academic years (2022-23, 2023-24, and 2024-25) across eleven critical parameters: Curriculum Design, Faculty Resources, Infrastructure, Financial Resources and Management, Teaching and Learning, Extended Curricular Engagements, Governance and Administration, Student Outcomes, Research and Innovation, Sustainability, and Best Practices.

The Workshop on Curriculum Design and Assessment Methods was jointly organised by the IQAC and the Teaching-Learning Centre of KCW on 11 February

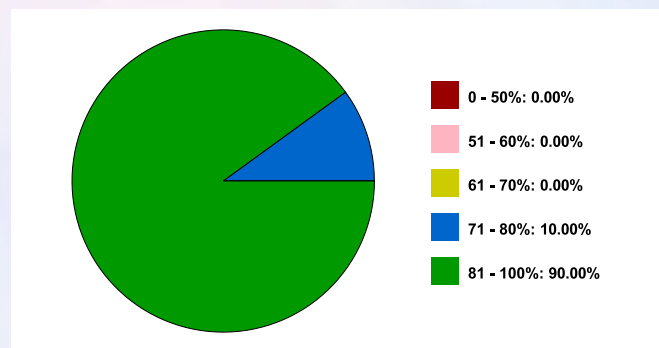

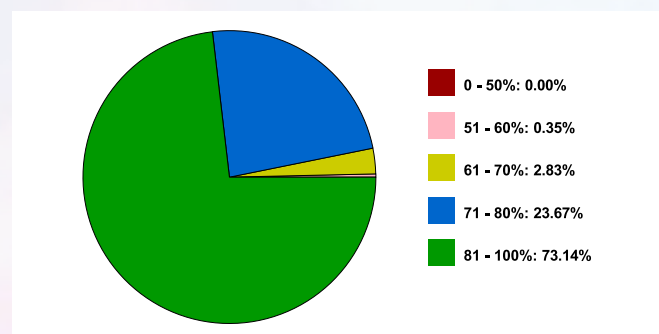
Percentage Pie Chart - Aided

Publications in SCOPUS Indexed Journals

The institution's research publications demonstrate significant academic impact and international collaboration. The impact factor of peer-reviewed journals in which the faculty have published ranges from 1 to 23.5, with an average impact factor of approximately 2–4. In 2025, the institution recorded a total of 2,406 citations with an H-index of 48, indicating the consistent quality and scholarly influence of its research output. The institution has also produced more than 65 international collaborative publications. Major collaborating countries include South Korea, the United States, Japan, and China, reflecting the global reach and interdisciplinary nature of the institution's research activities.



253 papers have been published in various SCOPUS indexed journals. The pie chart shows the distribution of publications across different academic fields. Engineering (12.7%) and Computer Science (12.0%) account for the largest specific shares, indicating a strong focus on technology-related research. Agricultural and Food Sciences (7.0%), Pure Chemistry (6.9%), Biochemistry, Genetics & Molecular Biology (6.5%), and Mathematics (6.5%) contribute moderate portions. Environmental Science (6.0%) and Social Sciences (6.0%) also have notable representation, while Decision Sciences (5.5%) and Economics, Econometrics & Finance (5.1%) have smaller shares. The Other category (25.9%) represents the largest overall portion, suggesting contributions from a wide range of additional disciplines.
