MINUTES OF THE MEETING

IQAC Coordinator Dr. J. Balavijayalakshmi, Associate Professor of Physics, welcomed the gathering. She presented an overview of the activities undertaken during the previous academic year and outlined the plans for the current academic year.

Board of Studies and Academic Council

The Board of Studies meeting for the Odd Semester of the academic year 2025–26 was held in hybrid mode from 27 March to 15 April 2025 for all programmes. A total of 240 courses were modified, and 107 new courses were introduced. The 32nd meeting of the Academic Council was held on 3 July 2025.

General Changes Implemented for the Academic Year 2025–26

- The mode of evaluation for the Comprehensive Examination for final-year Undergraduate and Postgraduate programmes has been revised to Internal Assessment, effective from the 2023 batch for UG programmes and the 2024 batch for PG programmes.
- Community Service is to be completed during Semesters I and II for UG programmes from the 2025 batch onwards. The results will be published along with the Semester III results.
- Field Work/Institutional Training is to be undertaken for 21 days at the end of Semester IV for UG programmes from the 2023 batch onwards. The results will be published along with the Semester V results.

Student Induction Programme

The Student Induction Programme for first-year UG students was conducted over four days from 16 to 19 June 2025.

The Postgraduate Student Induction Programme was conducted on 7 July 2025.

Faculty Induction Programme

The IQAC, in collaboration with the KCW Teaching-Learning Centre, planned to conduct a Faculty Induction Programme for newly recruited faculty members in July 2025.

Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA)

An Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) is scheduled to be conducted for the three-year period from 2022 to 2025 during the second and third weeks of August 2025.

AAA Audit Preparation

Departments are required to identify two faculty members from reputed colleges for the internal validation of the syllabus and academic processes. The experts should be selected based on their ability to provide constructive and critical feedback.

Leadership Training Programme

A Leadership Training Programme is planned to be organized for Students' Forum members in collaboration with the Lions Club in July 2025.

Faculty Orientation Programme

An Orientation Programme is planned to be organized for all faculty members of KCW in August 2025. The programme aims to familiarize faculty members with KCW's institutional vision and equip them to contribute actively towards upholding the college's legacy of excellence and innovation.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT

The **32nd meeting of the Academic Council** was held on 3 July 2025. The committee discussed the matters in detail and resolved to approve the minutes of the 32nd Academic Council meeting.

The **Student Induction Programme for UG students** was conducted from 16 to 19 June 2025 to welcome the new batch of students.

- On 16 June the inaugural programme was conducted. The Chief Guest, Thiru A. Saravana Sundar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Coimbatore, delivered an impactful speech. His address was followed by an inspiring talk by Ms. Priya Senthil, Guest of Honour and Motivational Speaker from S2S Personality Development Academy (P) Ltd. Further, Dr. J. S. Bhuvaneswaran, Director of Cardiology and Preventive Cardiology at PSG Hospitals, Coimbatore, addressed the students as Guest of Honour. The programme featured an address by alumna C. Sakunthala, Chartered Accountant at Sakunthala Girish & Associates LLP, Coimbatore, and Dr. Kaviya K., Founder and CEO of Create – The Ed Hub, Erode.
- On 17 June 2025, students were familiarised with the academic system, ICT facilities, e-Portal, library resources, and the activities of the Office for International Relations (OIR).
- On 18 June 2025, students were introduced to opportunities for community involvement through Outreach Programmes. They were also oriented towards Scholarship Opportunities and Financial Aid, Library and e-Resources, and Student Support Systems, followed by interactive sessions with their respective departments.
- On 19 June 2025, students were introduced to Yoga, Sports, and Fitness as part of the Student Induction Programme.

The **Postgraduate Student Induction Programme** was held on 7 July 2025 to welcome the new batch of PG students. The Chief Guest, Dr. R. Rajendran, Associate Professor of Botany, PSG College of Arts and Science, Coimbatore, delivered a motivational keynote address. Mr. Parthi Damodaraswamy, CEO, Institute for Lean System, Louisville, Kentucky, USA, delivered an enlightening talk, sharing global insights on leadership, innovation, and the potential of students in a rapidly evolving world.

The **Faculty Induction Programme** was organized on 14 and 15 July 2025 by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in collaboration with the KCW Teaching-Learning Centre. A total of 29 newly appointed faculty members participated in the programme and were oriented and equipped with the necessary knowledge and guidance to excel in their roles.

Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA)

An Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) was successfully conducted for the three-year period from 2022 to 2025 during the second and third weeks of August 2025. The audit was conducted in two distinct stages to evaluate and enhance academic quality, administrative efficiency, and institutional effectiveness.

Stage I: Academic Audit

The Academic Audit was conducted for all departments with the participation of 24 subject experts from various eminent institutions. The Self-Evaluation Reports prepared by the departments were shared with the respective subject experts prior to the audit. The experts verified the relevant documents, interacted with faculty members and students, and submitted their observations and recommendations in the prescribed audit report format.

Stage II: Administrative Audit

The Administrative Audit was conducted on 26 August 2025 by a panel of distinguished academic administrators:

1. Dr. R. Ganesan, Professor, School of Computer Science and Engineering, VIT Chennai
2. Dr. Baba Gnanakumar, Professor Commerce, Director for Consultancy and Corporate Training, Kristu Jayanti College, Bengaluru
3. Dr. V. Arulmurugan, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Commerce, School of Management, and Campus Coordinator, Pondicherry University

The team evaluated the performance of KCW for the three academic years 2022–23, 2023–24, and 2024–25 based on eleven critical parameters: Curriculum Design, Faculty Resources, Infrastructure, Financial Resources and Management, Teaching and Learning, Extended Curricular Engagements, Governance and Administration, Student Outcomes, Research and Innovation, Sustainability, and Best Practices.

The **Leadership Training Programme** was jointly organized by the IQAC and the Lions Club for Students' Forum members on 30 and 31 July 2025 at the Yukthi Hall from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. The programme featured distinguished guests, including PMJF A. Rajasekar, First Vice District Governor; MJF B. Ravishanker, GLT Coordinator; MJF Dr. P. Anandhakumari; and Lion V. Gregory Joseph, Guiding Lion of the Campus Club, PSGRKCW. A total of 110 students participated and benefited from the training programme.

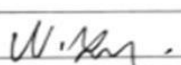
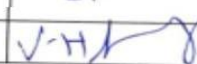
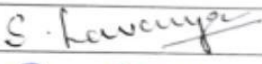
Faculty Orientation Programme

- The Board of Studies (BOS) is planned to be conducted in September 2025 for the Even Semester. If there are no major changes to the syllabus, approval may be obtained via email.
- The Academic Council Meeting is scheduled to be held in December 2025.
- A meeting of the Deans and Heads of Departments with the Chairperson is scheduled to be convened on 9 and 10 September 2025.

- Based on the suggestions and recommendations of the Audit Experts during the Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA), an Action Plan is to be prepared and presented to Dr. A. Shamitha Begum, Dean Academics, and the Secretary.
- Three years' data was collected and consolidated for the NAAC Accreditation Reform Survey.
- A workshop on “Harnessing AI for Effective Teaching, Learning, and Assessment” is planned to be conducted in association with the Teaching-Learning Centre (TLC).
- A Faculty Training Programme on Coursera Builder is planned to be conducted in association with the Skill Hub Team in October 2025.
- The IQAC has planned to conduct an Awareness Programme on Mental Health in association with the Department of Psychology for final-year UG and PG students.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT

Board of Studies (BoS) Meetings – Even Semester 2025–26

The Board of Studies (BoS) meetings for the Even Semester of the academic year 2025–26 were conducted in hybrid mode from 10 to 20 September 2025 for all programmes. The course content of existing courses was updated, and new courses were introduced in accordance with current trends and the skills required for the Even Semester. A total of 188 courses were revised and 62 new courses were introduced.

33rd Academic Council Meeting

The 33rd Academic Council Meeting was conducted in hybrid mode on 17 December 2025. In addition to the proposed curricular changes, the following academic provisions were approved:

- Study Abroad Programmes: Credits were allotted at the rate of 2 credits for 15 hours of learning
- Research/Semester Abroad: 10/20 credits were allotted.
- The Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) course, offered through the Siddhanta Knowledge Foundation, was introduced from the Even Semester of the academic year 2025–26 as an additional-credit course for Undergraduate and Postgraduate programmes. Students may opt for one IKS course per semester from Semesters II to VI for UG programmes and Semesters II to IV for PG programmes.

Review Meeting with the Chairperson

Heads of Departments, Deans, Cluster In-charges, and Centre of Excellence In-charges presented their departmental activities, student progression, future plans, and action plans to the Chairperson on 9 and 10 September 2025 in the Conference Hall. The Chairperson appreciated the comprehensive presentations and the efforts undertaken by the departments. The suggestions provided by the Chairperson were documented and shared with the concerned departments for further action and improvement.

Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA)

The AAA audit report was discussed with all departments. The departments were instructed to implement the suggestions and recommendations provided by the audit members.

NAAC Accreditation Reform Survey

The three-year data required for the NAAC Accreditation Reform Survey was submitted on 3 October 2025.

Workshop on Harnessing AI for Effective Teaching, Learning and Assessment

A workshop on “Harnessing AI for Effective Teaching, Learning and Assessment”, in association with the Teaching-Learning Centre (TLC), was conducted on 5 and 6 December 2025. A total of 61 faculty members from various departments participated and benefited from the programme. The resource persons were Dr. Vimal Jerold, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science, St. Joseph’s College, Tiruchirappalli, and Dr. Shantha Mary Joshitha, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Computer Science, Jeyaraj Annapackiam College for Women, Periyakulam.

Faculty Training Programme on Coursera Builder

The IQAC, in association with the Skill Hub Team, under the leadership of Dr. Raja Rajeswari and Dr. M. Selvanayagi, organized a Faculty Training Programme on Coursera Builder for faculty members of all departments on 23 October 2025. The training was conducted in four batches for faculty members across their respective domains, with the objective of enhancing effective content creation and developing assessments aligned with global standards.

Awareness Programme on Mental Health for All

An Awareness Programme on Mental Health for All was organized by the Department of Psychology in association with the IQAC over five days, from 18 December 2025 to 7 January 2026, comprising five sessions. The programme featured curated, interactive sessions for final-year UG and PG students. Conducted in an interactive and participative format, the programme engaged approximately 120 students per session, with a total of 2,345 beneficiaries.

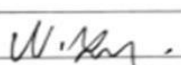
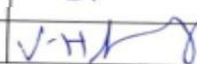
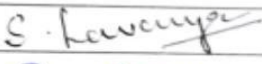
Mentoring Other Institutions

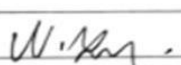
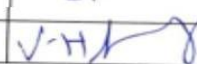
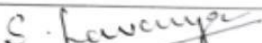
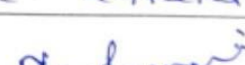
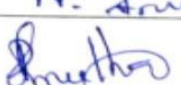
Workshop on Curriculum Design and Assessment Methods

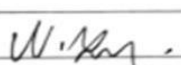
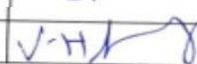
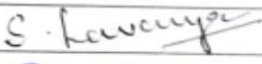
